More information on materials will be given when booking the class. If you book for a sewing class we ask that full payment be made on booking to secure your place. We also ask that if you wish to cancel you do so no later than one week before hand, if later than this we reserve the right to refuse a refund.

If we have to cancel a class due to not having enough interest we will let you know a week before the start date of the class and the option is then yours whether you receive a full refund or hold the money until a later class. We do not accept children under the age of 13 to our sewing classes unless the sewing class states differently. Every minor that attends a sewing class must be accompanied by an adult unless the class states differently.
